

## As Renovations End, Veterans' Home Seeks to Fill Vacancies

The Robert H. Jenkins State Veterans' Domiciliary in Lake City recently completed renovations to allow an increase in the number of veterans the facility can care for. Although there were limited beds for new residents while undergoing renovations, the home now has a number of vacant beds available for veterans who meet eligibility requirements for admission to a state veterans' home. The admission requirements include:

- Honorable discharged,
- Florida residency for at least one year at the time of applica-

tion,

- Infirmity caused by age or disease and/or incapable of earning a living, and
- Not in need of nursing home or hospital care.

The domiciliary is a 149-bed facility that provides a special combination of housing, personalized support services, incidental medical care, meal preparation, transportation to medical appointments, housekeeping services and activities.
