Today, we announced that Florida's unemployment rate is at the lowest it has been in eight years at 4.9 percent. We also learned that Florida's 24 regional workforce boards helped place more than 34,977 Floridians into jobs during February, including 1,758 veterans. This is great news for veterans and families who call Florida home.

When I took office, the unemployment rate was 10.7 percent. Our efforts to cut taxes over 55 times since 2010, including more than \$1 billion in taxes cut over the last two years, has saved Floridians \$5.5 billion. This has resulted in our private sector adding more than one million jobs in only five years. While these are incredible accomplishments for our state, we will continue to do all we can to support economic growth so Florida can be first in the nation for jobs
