DAVID MARZULLO

David Marzullo is Inspector General of the Florida Department of Veterans' Affairs in Largo, Florida.

Mr. Marzullo provides the central point for coordination of, and responsibility for, activities that promote accountability, integrity and efficiency in the department. The Inspector General conducts independent and objective audits, investigations and management reviews relating to department programs and operations.

Mr. Marzullo retired from the United States Drug Enforcement Administration in 2012 after more than 26 years of service. Mr. Marzullo served as a Special Agent and Supervisory Special Agent in Los Angeles and Paraguay, South America, as well serving as the Resident Agent in Charge of the Ventura Resident Office covering Ventura, Santa Barbara, and San Luis Obispo counties in California. Prior to joining the Florida Department of Veterans' Affairs Mr. Marzullo also served as the Director of Public Information and Community Outreach for the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department; and most recently as the Supervisory Investigator for the Chicago Independent Police Review Authority.

Mr. Marzullo, who is originally from Chicago, graduated from the University of Illinois with a Masters of Public Administration Degree; and Southern Illinois University with a Bachelor of Science Degree in the Administration of Justice. Mr. Marzullo also holds a certification of Inspectors General.
