

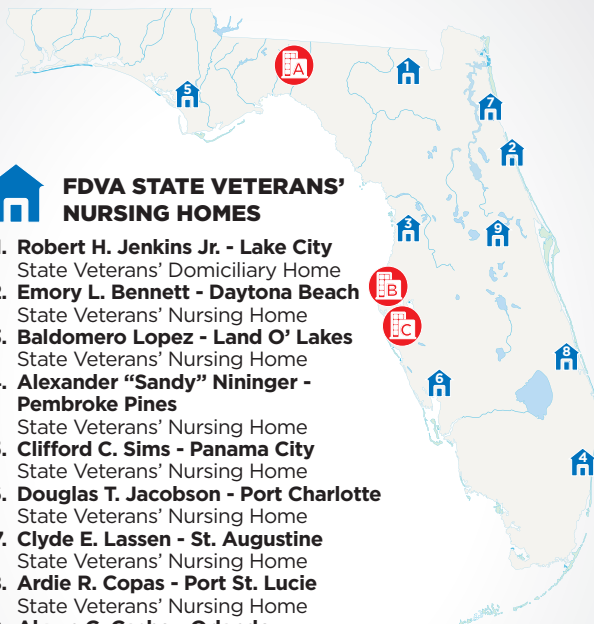
About FDVA

The Florida Department of Veterans' Affairs (FDVA) is a constitutionally chartered State Veterans' Affairs department responsible for serving the nation's third largest veteran population. Operating as the premier point of entry for Florida's 1.5 million veterans, FDVA operates a network of nine state Veterans' homes and provides statewide outreach to connect veterans with their earned services, benefits and support. The agency's Veterans' claims examiners play a major role in the direct infusion of more than \$23.9 billion annually for veterans into Florida's economy through federal compensation, education and pension benefits, U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs' medical services and military retired pay.



We take great joy in the relationship between our close-knit staff and the residents they lovingly serve at each of our veterans' homes – everyone valuing healthy life practices and supporting one another. 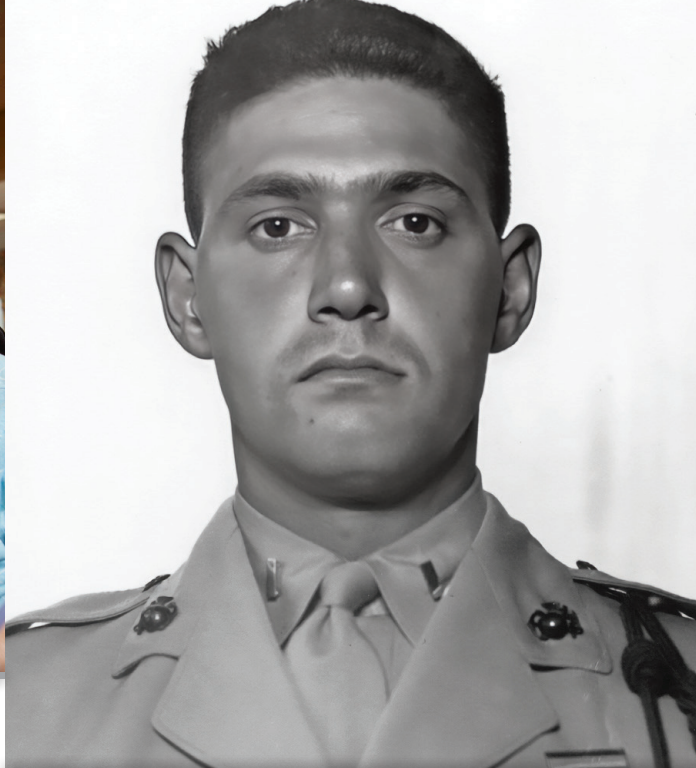


Who We Are

Korean War Medal of Honor Recipient Baldomero Lopez

The Baldomero Lopez State Veterans' Nursing Home is named after First Lieutenant Baldomero Lopez of the U.S. Marine Corps. First Lieutenant Lopez was post-humously awarded the Medal of Honor in recognition of his sacrifice when, wounded by enemy fire, he heroically pulled a live grenade under his body to shield his comrades from the blast.

Admission

Basic admission requirements include an honorable discharge from the Armed Forces, Florida residency at the time of application and a medical review and certification of need of skilled nursing care as determined by a physician. For additional information call (813) 558-5000.
